Summary Report Tire Track Comparison Proficiency Test #21401 Issued: August 13, 2021

On April 19, 2021, Ron Smith and Associates, Inc. (RS&A) shipped the Tire Track Comparison Proficiency Test #21401. Participants were required to submit their responses no later than July 12, 2021 in order for them to be included in this summary report.

A total of 9 tests were ordered and shipped, with 9 participants returning their responses. <u>This summary</u> **report is based on 36 individual responses (9 individual submissions returning 4 responses each).** The test was provided in hard copy format and included sectional photographs of known tire(s), known impressions of the tire(s), and four (4) questioned impressions.

The results presented in this report reflect whether or not the participants' submitted results agree or disagree with the assigned values garnered from pre-distribution testing and outlined in *The Manufacturer's Report* (Appendix 1). The primary purpose of a Summary Report is to provide an overall documentation of all the submitted responses. It is RS&A's intention to go a step further by providing more meaningful statistical results through analyzing the submitted responses in relation to the demographics obtained from each of the examiners participating in this proficiency test. All results and statistics for this test will be outlined through graphs and charts found in the remainder of this report.

Prior to distribution of this test, all the expected responses were determined, by internal and external consensus, to be either "Identification" (Association) or "Exclusion" (Non-Association); however, we are aware that some agencies allow for a conclusion of "Inconclusive" in their casework. In designing this Proficiency Test, there was no intention to force a participant to render a conclusion which goes beyond their considered opinion. To satisfy this option, participants were allowed to enter "Inconclusive" as a response. Due to the fact that a participant's "Inconclusive" response does not meet the assigned values, it will appear as an inconsistent response in this summary report and be incorporated as such in the statistical analysis. It will be up to each agency to decide if the participant's "Inconclusive" response qualifies as being acceptable under their policies and procedures.
